

PROHIBITION ON CONTRACTS WITH COMPANIES
DISCRIMINATING AGAINST FIREARM AND AMMUNITION INDUSTRIES

Pursuant to Section 2274 of the Texas Government Code, Respondent certifies that either (i) it meets an exemption criteria under Section 2274.003; or (ii) it does not discriminate against Firearm and Ammunition Industries, and will not discriminate against Firearm and Ammunition Industries, during the term of the contract resulting from this solicitation. Respondent shall state any facts that make it exempt from the certification in its Response.

Exemption criteria includes the following:

1. Company is a sole proprietorship;
2. Company employs less than 10 full-time employees;
3. Value of the contract is less than \$100,000

“Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association” means to refuse to engage in trade of goods and services with the entity or association or to refrain from continuing or terminate an existing business relationship with the entity or association based solely on its status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association. The term does not include established policies of a merchant, retail seller, or platform that restrict or prohibit the listing or selling of ammunition, firearms, or firearm accessories or an action taken to comply with law or a directive by a regulatory agency or for any traditional business reason that is specific to the customer and not based solely on an entity's or association's status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association.

“Company” is defined to mean a for-profit organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those entities or business associations that exists to make a profit.
